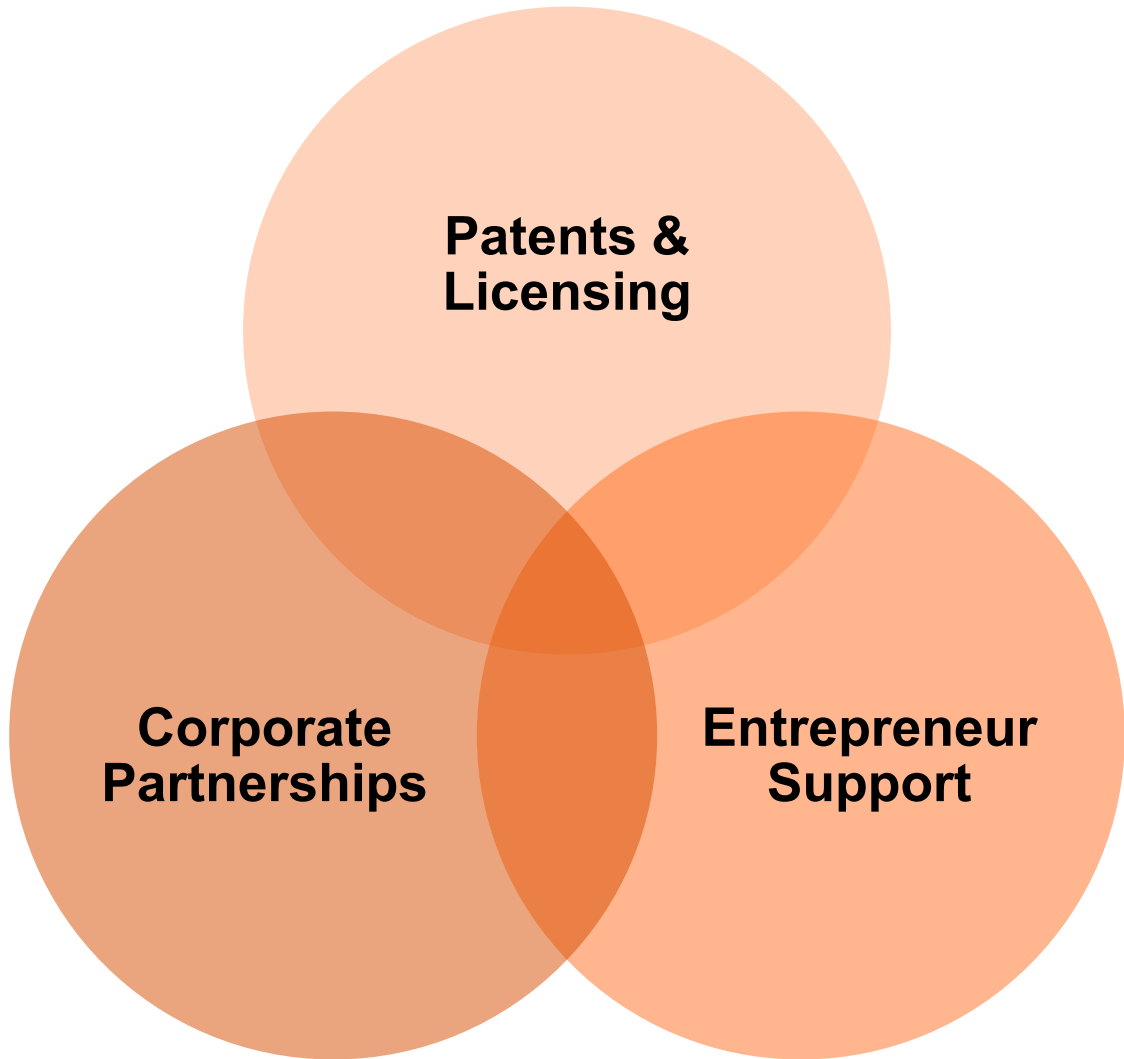

Patents & Licensing

Patents

- Process invention disclosures
- File provisional patent applications
- Manage patent portfolio and patent prosecution

Licensing

- Negotiate license agreements for Caltech IP
- Manage existing licenses with startups

Other IP Agreements

- Material transfer agreements (MTAs) (mta@Caltech.edu)
- Nondisclosure agreements (NDAs) – email licensing associate directly

Corporate Partnerships

Strategic Corporate Partnerships

- Manage long term relationships with strategic partners for multi-year, multi-center commitments
- Connect partners with new areas of faculty research

Sponsored Research

- Connect prospective partners to faculty and guide discussion
- Work with licensing team, OSR, and others to put new agreements in place

Corporate Gifts

- Secure corporate gifts (not private philanthropy)
- Negotiate and administer gift agreements
