

- The Library provides expert guidance on public access to research articles and data.
- As of July 1, the NIH requires immediate public access to publications from funded research.
- Starting January 1, all federal funding agencies will adopt similar policies.
- We offer:
  - Support for <u>NIH Public Access Policy</u> compliance
  - A curated list of <u>publisher policies</u> on public access
  - Help navigating data sharing requirements

### Research support

- General Grant Support: ORCID, collaborator reports, data management, SciENcv, etc.
- Support managing ORCID accounts for identity management and grant compliance.
- Open Access <u>Publishing Support</u>: Publish manuscripts Open Access (OA) for free or at a discount through the Caltech Library's agreements with several publishers.
- Consultations with <u>Subject Librarians</u> to help determine appropriate manuscript version to submit and submission process - email <u>library@caltech.edu</u>.
- CaltechAUTHORS can track open access status, personal and document identifiers, and other needed metadata.
- <u>CaltechDATA</u> can provide storage, manage public access, assign DOIs, and other services.
- Research Data Support: Consultations with Librarians for guidance on general data management and preservation, Data Management & Sharing Plans (DMSP's), and more.


